Brief History of OASIS Foundation



The OASIS Foundation was established in loving memory of late Mrs Oluwatohungbogbo Toluwalope Akinbo, (1977 - 2024), a triple-qualified registered, midwife, and ophthalmic nurse. Toluwalope's career spanned from 2006 to 2024 at the Lagos State Ministry of Health, where she dedicated her life to serving others with unmatched empathy, professionalism, and a joyful spirit. She was an Assitant Director of Nursing Services till her passing away.

Oluwatohungbogbo, affectionately known as Tohun, was not only a skilled healthcare professional but also a beacon of positivity and compassion.

Her dedication to patient care and her ability to uplift those around her left an indelible mark on her colleagues and patients alike. Her energy and passion for humanity were evident in every aspect of her work and life



In April 24th, 2024, after a courageous year-long battle with Acute Myeloid Leukemia (AML), Tohun passed away. Her passing left a void in the hearts of all who knew her, but her legacy of compassion and dedication lives on through the OASIS Foundation.

The foundation has been active for over 25 years through the generosity of Mr & Mrs Akinbo, mainly as educational support scholarship, medical expenses intervention and other charity work to anyone in the society and mainly those in their religious group and sphere of influence. Support for total strangers across the country have been done well. It was registered and named to continue Tohun's passion of making a positive impact on the lives of those less privileged and often disadvantaged by financial constraints.

In its formal registration and rebranding, It focuses on three main pillars: charity, medical outreach, and scholarships, reflecting Tohun's lifelong commitment to helping others. Through these initiatives, the OASIS Foundation aims to honor Tohun's memory by providing essential support to underserved communities, offering medical care to those in need, and empowering young individuals through education.

Tohun's spirit of generosity, her unwavering dedication to her profession, and her profound empathy for humanity remain the driving forces behind the OASIS Foundation. Her legacy continues to inspire and uplift, ensuring that her passion for helping others endures.



Charity Initiatives

Impact and Success Stories

The impact of the OASIS Foundation's work is evident in the stories of the individuals and communities it has touched. One such story is that of a widowed mother Mrs. E.N in the depths of depression who wanted to commit suicide. The 52 year old woman said she just saw the number online and sent a message as she did to so many random numbers out of desperation. She had lost a teenage child's life due to inability to pay a small medical bill. She has a daughter and was unable to feed or pay rent. She was contemplating suicide when she decided to reach out to anyone who could help with a job, even if it was cleaning or washing clothes.

She was visited by a co-worker then, her story and situation verified, and she was supported with house rent, a shop, food and provisions as well as money to setup and do business. Attached in this document are screenshots of her gratitude expressed. There are many more like that. People whose medical expenses were cleared, children's school fees paid for fully or in part and more.



We have provided financial support for students who gained admission into tertiary institutions and would not have been able to proceed without financial support. Subsidized school fees, and provided continuous upkeep for students. We have a standing continuous scholarship for students in higher institutions from financially challenged parents who maintain a CGPA above 3.5 or a minimum of Second Class Upper to encourage academic excellence.

One of the scholarship recipients, Miss A had a dream of becoming a graduate but the dream was at risk due to financial constraints. With the support of the OASIS Foundation, she completed her first degree and is now a professional, gainfully employed individual giving back to her family and helping others in need.

We have over the years supported individuals with disadvantaged circumstances to acquire vocational skills, secure jobs, establish businesses and much more. So, while the name may be newly registered, the first registration being in June 2023, and rebranded in April 2024 in honor of Mrs Akinbo, the couple have been doing the little they can over the years as earlier stated to light a candle in the dark world.

The above stories are just some of many that highlight the lifesaving impact of the foundation's support and scholarship initiatives and medical outreach programs.



2. Use of Data

3. Data Sharing

We do not share personal data with third parties unless:- It is required to deliver services (with partners or contractors who adhere to similar privacy standards), we are legally obligated to do so (e.g., government authorities or in response to legal processes), and the individual has given consent



4. Data Security
